Glede Past Simple in tega, kdaj uporabiti *have* in kdaj *had* (DZ str. 79, 1. nal.), ne pozabite, da **končnico –ed** (pri pravilnih glagolih) **oz. 2. obliko** (pri nepravilnih glagolih) uporabimo **samo v trdilnih povedih**. **V nikalnih in vprašalnih povedih** je za **didn't** oz. **did** vedno osnovna oblika glagola. Torej: My parents **had** two children. They **didn't have** a lot of money. **Did** they **have** a house?

Glede obeh preteklih časov je verjetno res najtežja stvar vedeti, kdaj moraš uporabiti enega in kdaj drugega. Če imaš morda s tem še težave, si lahko ogledaš tele video posnetke z razlago (objavljeni so tudi na moji spletni strani):

¹The rescue happened while we were on holiday in Australia last year. It was really amazing and ²I was lucky to get a photo of it.

I was walking along the beach with my family. There were a lot of big waves, and it was raining and windy. There was a man with a dog. He was walking on some rocks. ³Suddenly, a huge wave crashed into them. The man was OK, but I couldn't see his dog. After a few minutes, we saw the dog again. It was swimming, but it went under the water a few times. Two surfers on the beach were watching as well. ⁴As soon as they saw the dog, they swam towards it on their surfboards.

⁵When they reached the dog, they put it onto a surfboard. Then they swam back to the beach. ⁶They were very brave because the sea was dangerous.

LINKING EVENTS (povezovanje dogodkov)

when (ko): pogosto mu sledi Past Simple

When they reached the dog, they put it onto a surfboard.

(Eno dejanje je sledilo drugemu: najprej so prišli do psa, nato so ga dali na surf.)

while (medtem ko): vedno mu sledi Past Continuous

While they were skiing, Laura fell through the ice.

(Eno dejanje se je zgodilo, medtem ko je potekalo drugo: Laura se je poškodovala med smučanjem.)

as soon as (takoj ko): poveže dva dogodka, ki sta se zgodila (v obeh delih povedi je Past Simple)

As soon as they saw the dog, they swam towards it.

(Eno dejanje je takoj sledilo drugemu – lahko uporabimo tudi **when**, a se izgubi poudarek na takoj: Takoj ko so zagledali psa, so zaplavali proti njemu).

Vrstni red stavkov znotraj povedi je lahko tudi obrnjen, npr.:

Laura fell through the ice **while** they were skiing.

They swam towards the dog **as soon as** they saw it.
